Our brand new Boeing 787-9 [Dreamliner](#) lands at Gatwick Airport tomorrow where it will be used to serve our low-cost flights from the New York, Los Angeles and Fort Lauderdale to London. The 787-9 Dreamliner is 20 feet longer than the 787-8 Dreamliner and has a seating capacity of 344 seats (35 in Premium and 309 in economy).
